James 4:1-12

# The troublemaker is at war with himself (4:1-3)

- OWhy do we do what we do? "what causes quarrels and what causes fights among you?" (1a)
  - OBecause we want what we want. "you desire" (1b-2)
    - OJames 1:13-15
- OWhy don't we get what we want?
  - OBecause you do not ask (2b)
    - OJames 1:17

#### The troublemaker is at war with himself (4:1-3)

- Why don't we get what we want?
  - OBecause you ask for the wrong things (3a)
    - OJames 1:5
  - OBecause you ask for the right things in the wrong way
    OJames 1:19-20
  - OBecause you ask for the right things for the wrong reasons (3b)
    - OJames 1:6-8

# The troublemaker is at war with God (4:4-6)

- OThe troublemaker is adulterous (vs. 4a)
- OThe troublemaker is traitorous (vs. 4b)
- OThe troublemaker is idolatrous (vs. 5)
- OThe troublemaker is pompous (vs. 6)

#### The wise make peace with God (4:7-10)

- OHumility submits (vs. 7)
- OHumility seeks (vs. 8a)
- OHumility repents (vs. 8b)
- OHumility hurts (vs. 9)
- OHumility heals (vs. 10)

# The wise live at peace with others (4:11-12)

- OThe wise control their tongue (4:11a; 3:1-13)
- OThe wise don't show favoritism (4:11b; 2:8-11)
- OThe wise are doers of the Word (4:11c; 2:12-13; 1:22-25)
