 - What books were opened?

Sowing: The book of Ahab 1Kings 21:1-16

- Ahab's works:
 - Lawlessness (vs. 3)
 - Covetousness (vs. 1-4)
 - False witness (vs. 5-10)
 - Murder (vs. 11-13)
 - Stealing (vs. 14-16)

Sowing & Reaping

- Ahab lived to please himself (vs. 3)
- Ahab's way of life made him miserable (vs. 4)

Reaping: The Book of the Law 1Kings 21:17-29

- Ahab's way of life make him a slave (vs. 20, 25)
- God was patient with Ahab (vs. 29)
 - 2Pet. 3:9

Reaping: The Day of Judgement 1Kings 22

- Ahab scoffed at Elijah's prophecy
 - 2Pet. 3:3-4
- Ahab surrounded himself with liars (vs. 6-8)
- Ahab rejected Micaiah's prophecy (vs. 17-18)

Reaping: The Day of Judgment 1Kings 22 & 2Kings 9-10

- Elijah's prophecy was fulfilled
 - God brought Ahab to justice(1Kings 22:37)
 - 2Pet. 3:10
 - God brought Ahab's house to justice (2Kings 9&10)
 - God brought Jezebel to justice (2Kings 9:30-37)
